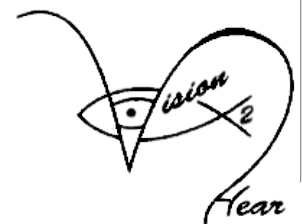

On behalf of our church and Work for Good Foundation we are so humbled and thankful from the bottom of our hearts for your generous support that enables us to help the helpless. God gave me burden to care for physically disabled people in our area, including those who attend our church. Now we are helping 40 physically disabled people, providing them with monthly groceries and also feeding them once a month.



We also provide monthly groceries, as well as medical care, clothing, toiletries and blankets for 53 widows and senior citizens in our community and in our church. In addition, we prepare curry three times a week, and our team distributes meals and bottled water to homeless people on the streets of our city, Vijayawada.
